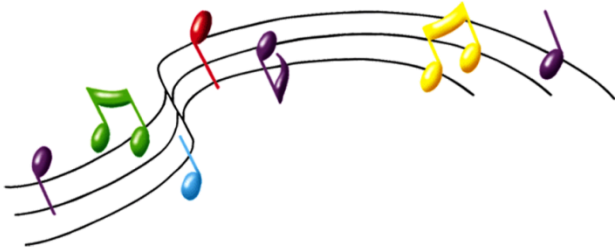

A Good song to know and sing when you may feel alone, or upset, or hopeless

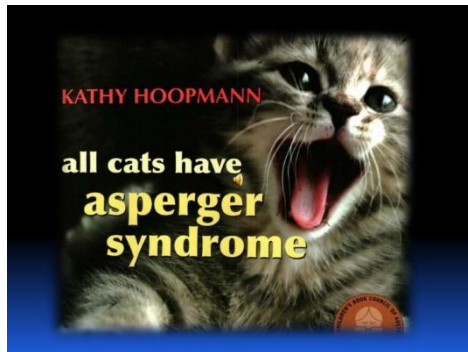

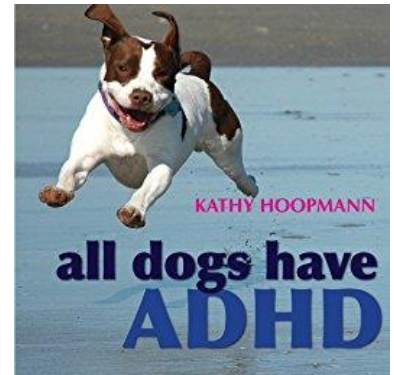
