

Long Strange Trip- a Unitarian Universalist History Documentary series screening @ The Unitarian Church in Westport, Spring '18

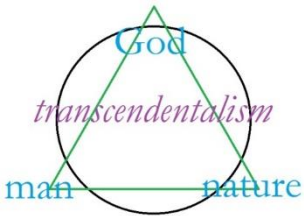


April 13, Friday, at 7pm- Meeting House

Part III: **American Unitarianism** (1620- 1860). The development of Unitarianism in America and its influence on Transcendentalism. Hosted by Randy Burnham

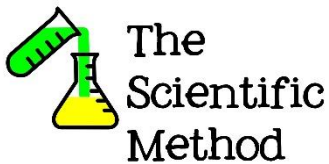
