Theme: Sanctuary

Topic: A place of protecting all beings

Principal #7: We care for our planet, our home, and all living things.

Today we spoke about animal sanctuaries and how we can care for all living things.

Sanctuary can be a place of worship, peace filled, safety and refuge.

Ask questions about what their places of refuge might be: Their room, their bed, being out in nature, Mommy's lap, bathtub, the garden, grandma's house, or going for a long drive?

Remind them that they can have more than one place they call a sanctuary.
