Theme: Trust

Topic: Trusting each other

UU Principal #2: All people should be treated fairly and kindly

- 1. FREE PLAY** (first 15 min.) SMILE, *greet families, sign-in children, get contact info, Welcome cards to new families.* Then
- 2. CALL to rug for CIRCLE TIME** (*Welcome Friends, Light chalice, Wonder box, Story*)
- 3. LIGHT CHALICE** – each child puts a felt Flame on the chalice
& **SING** “Light, light, light the Flame, Peaceful as a dove. Joyfully, joyfully, Joyfully, Joyfully, Fill the World with Love.

4. WONDER BOX: Place inside: Picture of Pinky Swear

To **pinky swear**, or to make a **pinky promise**, is the touching of the [pinkies](#) of two people to signify that a [promise](#) has been made.

How to Pinky Swear: 1) Two people entwine their pinkies 2) While pinkies are entwined, touch thumbs together 3) Release pinkies but keep thumbs touching and rotate hands to form a heart.

5. Discussion/ questions: When you make a promise to someone it’s important to try and keep that promise.

6. Story: The Frog Prince by Brothers Grimm (online)

Theme connection: A promise helps us trust each other. The Princess doesn’t want to honor her promise but her wise father insists.

7. Activity: Making friendship bracelets out of pipe cleaners. Give to a friend as a promise of your friendship.
